





#### **Glacier National Park**

Of the national parks I have visited over the years, Glacier National Park is perhaps the most stunning. There is so much to do here, especially for those who like to hike.



#### Salt Creek Rec Area-Port Angeles, Washington

Salt Creek Recreation Area is a county park located about 15 miles west of Port Angeles, Washington. The park was previously Camp Hayden, used during World War II as a harbor defense base. There are still several structures left from the fort, including two concrete bunkers which housed 16" guns and several other structures.

The park is located on a bluff above the Strait of Juan de Fuca and offers views of the Strait of Juan de Fuca, Crescent Bay, and Vancouver Island, British Columbia.





#### Odessa, Missouri

#### Cherokee, NC

I arrived in Cherokee, NC specifically to view the solar eclipse of August 22, 2017. Cherokee was in the path of totality.





On August 28, 2017, the price of the America the Beautiful – The National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Senior Pass will increase from \$10 to \$80. This increase is a result of the Centennial Legislation P.L. 114-289 passed by the US Congress on December 16, 2016 and is the first increase since 1994.

The lifetime Senior Passes provide access to more than 2,000 recreation sites managed by six federal agencies:

- National Park Service
- US Fish & Wildlife Service
- Bureau of Land Management
- Bureau of Reclamation
- US Forest Service
- US Army Corps of Engineers

The passes cover entrance and standard amenity (day-use) recreation fees and provide discounts on some expanded amenity recreation fees. For more details about the pass, visit <a href="Changes to the Senior Pass">Changes to the Senior Pass</a>.

To purchase this pass any federal recreation site, including national parks, that charges an entrance or standard amenity (day-use) fee. You can also purchase online or through the mail from USGS; an additional \$10 processing fee will be added to the price. Visit the USGS store.
