Using Amateur Radio While Visiting National Parks: How it was done

During 2016 the National Parks Service celebrated their 100th anniversary. Two inventive folks at the amateur radio headquarters came up with a clever way to recognize and publicize this event by creating "National Parks On The Air" (NPOTA). Margie befriended both of them. Norm Fusaro is shown in picture 1 with Margie, and the other young man with the original concept, not shown, was Sean Kutzko.



They started a brand new radio adventure by requiring amateurs transmitting


or "activating" within the boundaries of the park. They also required 25 responding radio amateurs or "chasers" to verify the activator transmissions through a national computer based call registry. Sean handled the National Parks locations and Norm concentrated on the national call registry.

For us this was almost a dream come true. We were able to combine our Wanderlust with our Amateur Radio hobby. Margie would make all over the air contacts and I would handle all the travel and technical logistics and do the laptop data entry. In picture 2 Margie is talking to a chaser and my data entry laptop is to the right of the steering wheel.

Using the cell phone as a "Hot Spot" Margie is forwarding our chaser contacts to the call registry. To make sure at least 25 chasers have also entered their activator reception data into the call register, we would make 60 to 80 contacts. Many chasers just participated in the fun activity without being part of the registry. The pile-ups were classical. Margie has a unique talent for recognizing parts of a call sign and repeating it. Like magic, everyone became quiet and only the requested station would answer. The park details and reception reports were shared along with Margie's unique pleasantries. Although we transmitted SSB with less than 100 watts with our ICOM 7100, her very pleasant female voice acted like a virtual kilowatt. Then we checked several times if at least 25 chasers verified our transmission as shown in picture 3. If not, then we continued the process. Most of the time everything worked out great on the first attempt, and we had plenty of time to visit the park site.

This process we repeated at 73 different National Parks between South

Carolina to Maine, Florida and California throughout the year. Margie made about 4700 contacts overall. Afterwards she sadly suffered for three months from a Trigger Thumb from pressing the PTT button. Now we use a foot switch. To verify our presence at the parks, we always took snapshots as shown in picture 4.



The activity is still viable with very relaxed rules as POA (Parks On The Air).

The website is parksontheair.com . It is organized by a separate group of amateurs not associated with the 2016, 100th anniversary version.

Our RV based amateur radio station is shown in picture 5, along with the 32ft "Eagle One" collapsible vertical antenna right above a MFJ tuner in a rain proof enclosure, all mounted on the ladder. The entire revised setup in our present RV will be the subject of another article. And yes, I did climb the ladder 146 times to set-up and take down the antenna. The orange Clemson Tiger Paw works as another travel fun factor in the form of unexpected horn honks from passer byes and thumbs-up gestures.
